
## **Farms Skipper**

The successful candidate will be required to work on a **two week on/two week off rotational basis**, providing an excellent work/life balance opportunity. ### About the job

This role is a crucial member of the operations team and the successful candidate will need to work closely with the Farm Manager and Site Supervisors to provide the most efficient service to the farms. We need our employees to strive for continuous improvement. The job includes, but is not limited to:

- Ensuring daily mortality removal
- Feed transport from the shore base to the farm
- Assisting with net changing/cleaning
- Harvesting/ Passive grading
- Assisting with fish treatments
- Maintain boat cleanliness and biosecurity, ensuring relevant records are kept up to date
- Maintaining the vessel to a high standard, ensuring full compliance at all times to workboat code and certification
- Managing the maintenance of engines, machinery and equipment on board the vessel
- Other general farm duties e.g. hand feeding as part of the weekend feeding squad as required

### Ideal candidate

The ideal candidate should have an interest in the aquaculture industry and be willing to learn, with a can-do attitude and a positive approach to solving problems. They will be willing to expand their understanding and work hard on the job.

- Previous skipper experience is essential, and familiarity with aquaculture operations is desirable
- Certification to operate a vessel up to 24 metres, day and night
- You will be required to hold, or able to obtain, and retain an ML5 or ENG1 medical certificate
- Flexible approach to working to meet the demands of the job
- Ability to understand the aims of the site and to support the rest of the team to achieve these
- Respect for the need for safe working practices
